GETTING TO THE HOSPITAL...

Drive

Patients who are enrolled on a Clinical Trial at RMH, receive priority parking in the main hospital car park (entrance via Royal Parade). Please ask your study nurse for a Priority Cardholder Parking Card.

Tram

- 19 tram (City to North Coburg), runs along Royal Parade. You can catch this from Flinders Street or Melbourne Central stations and get off at the corner of Grattan Street
- 59 tram (City to Airport West), runs along Flemington Road. You can catch this from Flinders Street or Melbourne Central stations and get off at the corner of Grattan Street
- 58 tram (Toorak to West Coburg), runs along Flemington Road. You can catch this from Flagstaff station and get off at the corner of Grattan Street

Bus

- 401 bus travels from North Melbourne train station to the hospital (weekdays only)
- 402 bus (East Melbourne to Footscray via North Melbourne) runs past the hospital

Train

Catch a train to North Melbourne station then the 401 bus from North Melbourne station to the hospital (weekdays only).

Taxi


There is a taxi rank on Grattan Street, outside the main entrance.

PRIORITY CARDHOLDER PARKING

This card entitles the cardholder to park in the Royal Melbourne Hospital Car Park (enter via Royal Parade)

**PROCEED TO THE CAR PARK
EVEN IF CAR PARK IS FULL**

Keep this card with you and present to parking attendants as required



ONCE I ARRIVE AT THE HOSPITAL, WHERE DO I GO?

The Clinical Trials Centre is located on Level 2 South.

When you arrive, if you are unsure where to go, ask one of our friendly volunteers (they will be wearing red!) or the information desk staff just inside the main entrance of the hospital.

Whether you enter the hospital via the main entrance on Grattan Street or from the car park on Royal Parade, the easiest way to find the Clinical Trials Centre is to:

- Follow the blue line marked on the floor, which will direct you to the Centre Lifts
- There are 6 lifts, and you can take any of these up to the 2nd Floor
- Once you exit out of the lift, look for a sign for **Level 2 South - Clinical Trials Centre**, and walk down the corridor in that direction for around 25 metres
- As shown on the map, you will walk past a second set of 2 lifts, and you will then need to turn to the right
- Press the doorbell at the entrance to the Clinical Trials Centre, and our Receptionist will welcome you inside for your visit



WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

- The Clinical Trials Centre is fully accessible to those in wheelchairs or with mobility issues. Your carer, spouse, family member or friend is very welcome to come along with you.
- There is a waiting room with comfortable sofas, a kitchenette and TV to relax before your visit.
- There is also a bathroom and toilet in the Clinical Trials Centre for your use.
